Standard 1.8: Monitoring of Prevention, Screening, and Outreach Opportunities

According to the 2016 Community Needs Assessment for Princeton Baptist Medical Center, cancer is the second leading cause of death in Jefferson County, Alabama. Local breast and prostate cancer occurrences rank higher than that of the state of Alabama and the United States. Community lung and bronchus cancer rates fall lower than those in Alabama but higher than the United States. For these reasons, Princeton Baptist Medical Center places a heavy focus on the early detection and prevention of cancer within our community through numerous outreach opportunities.

Community Outreach and Education opportunities were presented through our partnership with Fox 6's Good Day programming on the following:

Procedures for Procession of Abnormal Screening Results at Community Events:

- 1. Patient is contacted directly by screening coordinator to review results
- 2. A Copy of the Results is provided to the patient and also shared with patient's physician if so authorized
- 3. A letter detailing the screening results is also mailed to the patient's home.
- 4. Patient is advised to seek counsel of physician for further treatment and/or diagnosis.

NOTE: If the patient does not have a physician, the screening coordinator will assist in finding a suitable physician for a follow up appointment and assist in scheduling that appointment.
